PEDAL PRIX 2019



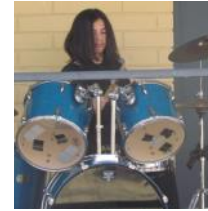

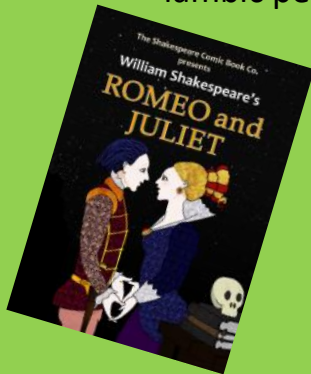




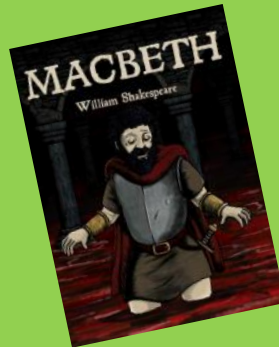
Love and War

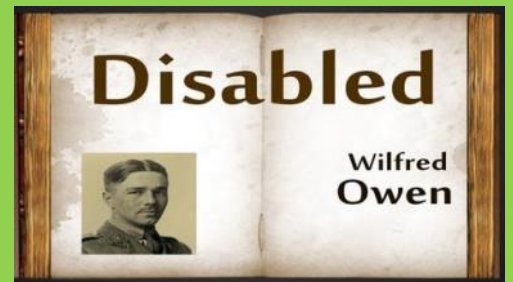

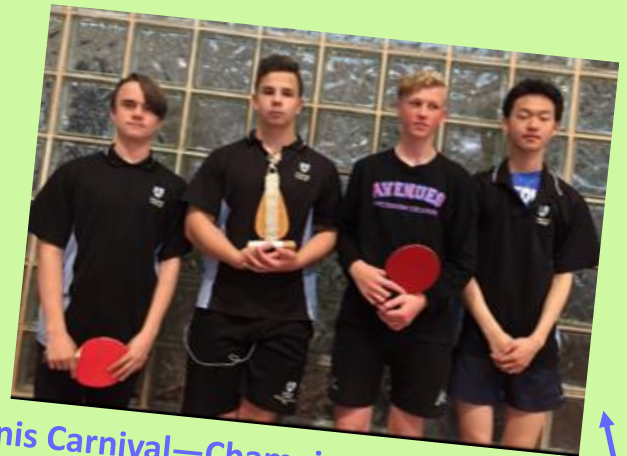
