In the Reception classes we use a multi-sensory approach to learning letter sounds, or *Body, Hands, Mind*. The students use their bodies to do actions for each letter of the alphabet, sing songs about letter to embed the sounds, manipulate materials to support letter formation and focus on visuals to embed letter recognition.


## English Students Get a Taste of Live Theatre.
